Critical junctions are tied together with heat shrunk connectors.

## TECHNOLOGICALLY ADVANCED DESIGN, SUPERIOR MATERIALS, FIRST-CLASS FIT AND FINISH



Bonefish boats are designed using a semi-monocoque technique to promote strength and rigidity, and are constructed from premium uv-resistant gelcoat, epoxy vinyl ester resin and high-density fiber-reinforced transom board.

A vacuum assisted infusion process is used to construct the aramid (Kevlar™), carbon fiber and fiberglass composite parts. These superior laminates make Bonefish boats both light and strong.
